Purpose/Outcome(s)



- A. Work as team to complete a task dependent on our 7 Benchmarks:
 - 1. Mission Driven Leadership
 - 2. School Culture and Design
 - 3. Student Outreach, Recruitment, and Retention
 - 4. Teacher Selection, Development and Retention
 - 5. Curriculum, Instruction, and Assessment
 - 6. Strategic Alliances
 - 7. Academy Advancement and Sustainability
- B. Reflect as a team on the parallels between this activity and the current realities of our model

Instructions



1. Break large group into teams

- Whole table teams
- One person from each table reports to the front/right of the room
- One person from each table reports to the back/left of the room
- Remaining people split into Jan-June (middle) vs July-December teams (high)

2. Arrange participants into a circle, facing each other

- Ask them to hold out their arms
- Tie each group together so that each person is tied to both neighbor's wrists

3. Give the tied up groups a task

- Make a school uniform for your academy with the materials in your package
- Modify the materials
- Use your imaginations

4. Time Limit

- 20 Minutes
- 5. Be ready for changing expectations

Changing Expectations



- 1. Two teams become one
- 2. It might rain today...(in the last two minutes)
- 3. Heatwave in the forecast?
- 4. Mark of a ...great teacher something green; somewhat great – something orange; ok – something blue
- 5. Accessories, accessories
- 6. The missing link
- 7. A day late and a dollar short


Questions
