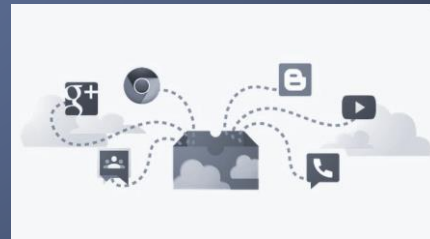
- Share Critical Friends and Faculty Meeting Agendas prior to meetings
