Academic Degrees

Associate of Art (AA)

The Associate of Art is intended primarily for the pursuit of a baccalaureate degree in the areas of Business, Social Sciences, Humanities, or Fine Arts. The core curriculum facilitates the transfer of lower-division course credit among Texas public colleges, universities, and health-related institutions.

Associate of Science (AS)

The Associate of Science is intended primarily for the pursuit of a baccalaureate degree in the areas of Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics (STEM) or Life & Physical Sciences. The core curriculum facilitates the transfer of lower-division course credit among Texas public colleges, universities and health-related institutions.
